

# Hurricane Safety Kit

Knowing where to go, and what to take, before a hurricane warning is issued is key. Have an evacuation plan and plenty of supplies. Do not ignore evacuation orders because it can quickly become too late.

## Evacuation Tips:



- Find a boarding facility for your family pets.
- Identify more than one route in case you encounter roadblocks.
- Share the plan with your loved ones.
- Have your bags packed and be ready to leave if directed to do so by officials.
- Stay tuned to the local weather news and emergency alerts.
- Fully charge laptop computers and mobile devices.
- Keep important documents stored safely, either physically or in digital form.

## Hurricane Supplies:



- Pack a week's worth of food, water, and a can opener.
- Gather a month's worth of medication and first aid supplies.
- Grab extra batteries, a flashlight, radios, and a hand crank phone charger.
- Fill up on a full tank of gas and get a few extra plastic gas cans.
- Have cash on hand in case ATMs flood or power goes out.
- Consider needs of pets, such as pet food and medicine.
- If you cannot evacuate and are forced to take shelter, use a generator outdoors and stay away from windows.
